Final Communiqué

The Court of Auditors held in the Auditorium of the Palace of Justice, in Luanda, on the 8th, 9th and 10th of April 2026, the Scientific Conferences alluding to its 30th Anniversary, under the motto: ***"30 Years of Financial Justice: Modernization, Integrity and Cooperation"***.

The Counsellor President of the Court of Auditors, **Dr. Sebastião Domingos Gunza**, addressed the welcome message to the participants and, in praising the 30 years of the Court, paid tribute to the first Presidents and all those who contributed to its consolidation. Underlining the significant evolution recorded over three decades, he highlighted the institution's ability to adapt to the challenges of each era, asserting itself as a protagonist of its transformation, with an action increasingly oriented towards the promotion of solutions and not only towards the verification of legal compliance.

In this context, he called for the need to adopt a new paradigm of external control, with a focus on assessing the impact of public policies on the lives of citizens, with a view to contributing to the improvement of public management.

The opening ceremony was presided over by His Excellency, Minister of State and Chief of Staff of the President of the Republic, **Dr. Dionísio Manuel da Fonseca**, representing **His Excellency the President of the Republic, João Manuel Gonçalves Lourenço**. In his communication, he emphasized that the Court of Auditors is a pillar of the balance of state powers and public financial discipline, which is indispensable for democracy, transparency and good governance.

The event was attended by the Chief Counsellor of the Constitutional Court, the Chief Counsellor of the Supreme Military Court, the Vice-President Counsellor Judge of the Supreme Court, the Counsellor Judges of the Superior Courts of Angola, Members of the National Assembly, Auxiliaries of the

Head of the Executive Power, the Attorney General of the Republic, the Ombudsman, the Presidents of the Courts of Auditors of Portugal, São Tomé and Príncipe, the First President of the Court of Auditors of Senegal, the Ministers of the Court of Auditors of the Union, the President of the Court of Auditors of the State of Rio Grande do Sul, the President of the 4th Chamber of the Moroccan Court of Auditors, the Presidents of the Rui Barbosa Institute, the Association of Members of the Courts of Auditors of Brazil and the Brazilian Association of the Courts of Auditors of the Municipalities, the Counselors of the Courts of Auditors of the States of Tocantins, Minas Gerais, Amazonas, Alagoas and Amapá, the representative of the Secretary General of AFROSAI-E, Magistrates of the Public Prosecutor's Office, prominent Full Professors of the Agostinho Neto University, the Federal University of Tocantins, the Faculty of Law of the New University of Lisbon, the Lusófona University of Lisbon, the University of São Paulo, the Pontifical Catholic University of São Paulo, the Federal University of Tocantins, the Federal University of Palmas, the Military Academy of Lisbon, the representative of the Judiciary Police of Portugal, the Karina Leite *Dental-Clinic* Institute, the employees of the Court of Auditors, the academic community and guests.

More than 600 people **participated in the Conferences, in person**, and the event was viewed on various digital platforms by hundreds of users.

After the opening ceremony, the 3rd Edition of the Flux da Corte Magazine, the 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th Edition of the Reports of Jurisprudence and the 4th Edition of the Scientific Journal of the Court of Auditors were launched. The availability of these works is a relevant milestone in the consolidation of the Court's institutional memory and contributes to strengthening transparency, accessibility to case law and the promotion of scientific research.

Subsequently, congratulatory messages were presented on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the Court of Auditors, in virtual format, by the First President of the

Court of Auditors of Morocco, Dr. Zineb El Adaoui, and by the former President of the Court of Auditors of Portugal, Judge Counsellor José Tavares.

As part of the international exchange, the Technical Cooperation Agreement between the Court of Auditors of Angola and the Court of Auditors of the State of Amazonas was signed, with a view to modernizing the external control systems of inspection through actions aimed at the development of exchange programs of experiences and the exchange of information, especially on environmental audits.

The debates were marked by high scientific rigor and constructive spirit, contributing to the strengthening of technical and institutional knowledge in the field of financial justice, resulting in the following conclusions:

1. The principle of consensuality in the Courts of Auditors is a modern mechanism of external control that should actively contribute to the improvement of public management, avoiding blockages that may compromise the public interest;
2. The Jurisdictional Branch has the competence to supervise and control Public Policies and, in case of omission or mismanagement of public resources, must alert the Executive to ensure legality, efficiency and the expected impact on the social and economic life of the country, without prejudice to the principles of financial responsibility, administrative discretion and separation of powers.
3. The relevance of public governance based on transparency, integrity, responsibility and fiscal sustainability is a fundamental pillar for the preservation of the public interest and for the protection of future generations.
4. Innovation and use of advanced technologies, including Generative Artificial Intelligence, digital solutions and search engines.

compliance that strengthen the capacity for analysis, risk prevention and automation of procedures are fundamental to increasing the effectiveness, scope and timeliness of the inspection action of the Courts of Auditors.

5. The quality of institutional performance, which directly depends on investment in human capital, professional motivation, occupational health and the construction of inclusive and healthy work environments, was pointed out as an essential condition for the consolidation of strong, modern and sustainable institutions.
6. Financial autonomy is crucial to ensure impartiality, institutional stability and the ability of Supreme Audit Institutions to act in the face of the growing demands of public financial control.
7. International cooperation is an essential vector for the strengthening of Supreme Audit Institutions, by allowing the sharing of experiences, the harmonization of good practices and the development of joint strategies to face common challenges in the field of financial justice.

At the end of this cycle of lectures, the Court of Auditors of Angola reaffirms its continued commitment to promoting more efficient, transparent and collaborative financial justice, in line with the principles of good governance and sustainable development for the benefit of society and future generations.

The participants welcomed the organization of the event and congratulated the Court of Auditors of Angola for the celebration of its 30th anniversary.
